APPRENTICE RIVER PILOTS

Minimum Requirements:

- A baccalaureate degree from a recognized and duly certified college or university, or from a maritime academy operated by the United States or a state, or
- A United States Coast Guard issued license to serve as a third-mate on all oceans or master in near coastal waters aboard vessels of no less than 1600 tons, or a higher class of license.
- Copy of driving record.
- Criminal background check at own expense.
- Minimum age of 21.

Applicants must complete an application and questionnaire and send it to the below address no later than **August 1, 2006**. A fee of \$99, by check or money order only, made payable to the State of Delaware must accompany the application.
